Review and testing over the following

Testing for Drawing ability:

(Review and drawing tests)

- Capturing the essence of different racial groups.
- Drawing male and female faces.
- Shading
- Accessory items: hats, glasses, mustaches and beards
- Communicating visual information
- Exactness of drawing.

General knowledge

(Review and written test)

- History of forensic art
- Terminology, ethics
- Standard operating procedure
- Other information

Interview Skills

(Review and video taped test)

- The cognitive interview
- Signs of deception: verbal, physical and statement analysis
- Memory

Who should take this class: The class is open by invitation only to qualified students who meet the requirements for the Certification course. After successful completion of this review and testing class, participants will receive a certificate and test results.
